§ 6-1. Ambulance service.¹

The Town Board hereby elects to operate and maintain ambulance service for Washington Island in the Town of Washington.

§ 6-2. Name of ambulance service.

The name of the ambulance service shall be the "Washington Island Rescue Squad."

§ 6-3. Purchase of equipment.

The Town Board may purchase equipment for medical and other emergency calls which equipment shall belong to the Town of Washington.

§ 6-4. Employees.²

The Town Board shall hire such persons as are necessary to provide ambulance service for the Town of Washington, and such persons shall be employees of the Town of Washington.
